Uncover the Legacy of Ulysses S. Grant at Morningside Heights

Located in picturesque Morningside Heights, the General Grant National Memorial stands as a testament to our nation's history. This classical domed mausoleum, reminiscent of the hills of Arlington National Cemetery, is a hidden gem on West 122nd & Riverside Dr. Operated by the esteemed National Park Service, it proudly holds the title of the largest mausoleum in North America. Within its walls, First Lady Julia and President Ulysses S. Grant rest in two marble sarcophagi, surrounded by busts of generals and lawmakers from Grant's time. Above them, a rotunda resembling the U.S. Capitol is adorned by four tile frescoes, each depicting a significant moment from Grant's service in the Union Army. The main level houses two majestic anterooms, each with a vivid depiction of the most important battles of the Civil War, accompanied by cases displaying the corresponding Union Army flags.

When it was initially erected and dedicated in 1897, it drew millions of visitors and continued to be a major and highly visited New York City landmark throughout the early 1900s. Several influential global and national figures would be hosted there and paid tribute to one of the great icons and heroes in American history. In the 1960s and 1970s, however, as crime began to become rampant in New York City, it became a target of vandalism. It began to diminish in importance and trend towards being forgotten until its recent revival in

the late twentieth century, which was spearheaded by Frank Scuttaro, the president of the Grant Monument Association.

When we visited the tomb, Scuttaro gave an extremely informative lecture on the history of the site and his efforts to revive it during his time at Columbia University in the 1990s. Over the past three decades, he has worked tirelessly to transform the site from a once-defaced memorial to a pristine beacon to one of our nation's most consequential generals and presidents. The site also has a visitors center where you can learn more about the memorial, purchase books, and Grant memorabilia. Scuttaro gave his presentation in the visitors center's conference room to a standing-room only audience. The grounds surrounding the memorial are vast, and the area is a quiet hamlet in bustling Manhattan. For members of the New York Young Republican Club, the General Grant National Memorial is a must-see historical destination.

The Grant Monument Association continues its efforts today to keep and maintain the memorial tomb. It regularly reaches out to representatives at the federal and state level for funding for the necessary maintenance of this great monument. The Association also hosts events to fundraise and continue support for the initiative. Our NYARC History Committee recently attended the Association's Annual Dinner at the Union League to commemorate Grant's birthday. This year, retired American war hero General David H. Petraeus participated in a colloquy with Donald L. Miller, author of the book, "Vicksburg" to discuss Grant's Civil War campaign during the Siege of Vicksburg and how it was a turning point in the Civil War for the Union forces. The event was very informative and filled with attendees. We were grateful for the opportunity to have attended and continue to support the efforts of the Grant Monument Association. We would encourage our members to visit the Memorial and attend various events the Association hosts throughout the year. The Tragedy of The Islamification of Persia (Iran): A Lesson for The West

Iran was one of the fastest growing economies during the 1960s and early 70s. It was one of the first nations to allow women to vote and America’s closest ally in the Middle East alongside Israel. The Persian Pahlavi Shah was rapidly developing the country’s economy and was the main powerhouse which kept the region stable. The present state of the country however is a dystopian society where the violation of women’s rights is a part of the country’s constitution, the economy is on the verge of collapse and the leaders of the nation are the main sponsors of terrorism, radicalization of the youth and anti-Western propaganda, not just in the Middle East, but across the world.

Nowadays many intellectuals debate over the cause of the rapid decay of this once prosperous Middle-Eastern powerhouse, but the answer is very simple - Islam happened. The same way it is currently happening across the West, predominantly in France, Sweden, and The United Kingdom. Many patriots across the West solely blame this takeover on immigrants and asylum seekers from countries with Islamic value systems, but neglect the real

threat which is the naivety of millions of self-proclaimed liberal native Westerners who vote for individuals and policies that allow this takeover to expand.

The 1979 revolution of Iran is exactly what many Islamist inhabitants of Western countries are trying to manifest. The state of Iran during the last five years before the revolution had many similarities to the current state of many Western countries. During those years, native citizens of the country had absolutely no control over a variety of economical and social shifts which were being implemented by the Shah onto the population. Just like the many allegiances that are happening in the West against the centralization of power, intellectuals of all backgrounds in Iran formed alliances to deal with the tyrannical behaviors of the Shah. Ayatollah Khomeini and his Islamist cult lied to many non-Muslim citizens of Iran that he is going to help create a more democratic Iran if he ever becomes their leader.

Many intellectuals and politicians in European countries, such as France, also believed this Islamist’s proposals and gave him platforms so that he could broaden his reach. Ayatollah Khomeini and his Islamist followers formed a coalition with millions of Iranian leftists and eventually lead a leftist revolution against the Shah. Ayatollah Khomeini became the new ruler of Iran and unlike what he promised, he executed all other political alternatives including thousands who were a part of his own coalition and instead of a democratic Iran, he established the Islamic Republic of Iran.

Most of the Christian, Jewish, Zoroastrian, secular, and non-Muslim Iranians fled the country and thousands were imprisoned, murdered or at best downgraded to second class citizens. The rich Persian culture of Iran started to slowly fade away due to the enforcement of hardliner Islamic values by the order of the new Islamic leadership. Ayatollah Khomeini and the followers of his Islamic anti-West death cult did not have the facilities or the education to achieve this revolution. They simply utilized the minds of thousands of educated naive leftists. Many of these leftist intellectuals believed that Islam is not truly a violent ideology of death but simply a misunderstood culture that is heavily judged by non-Muslims which is identical to the present

happenings in Northern Europe. Iran went from a vibrant nation filled with innovation, art and culture to a barbaric authoritarian Islamic dictatorship which did not tolerate any of its former traits.

The tolerance and romancing of Islam by Western liberals is one of, if not, the biggest cause for the opening of a gateway towards a fate similar to that of Iran. Millions of leftist Western citizens fail to understand the fascistic nature of the religion of Islam and how it is ideologically designed to take over all other cultures that it touches. The combination of economic and social unrest, corruption, a generation of fragile chronically online incapable young men and Islamist influencers radicalizing millions of minds on media platforms, is creating a population that is extremely easy to ideologically hijack. Leftist naivety in the West has labeled individuals such as Donald Trump, Marine Le Pen and many other politicians who have tried to shine a light on this issue as racists and bigots, not understanding that it is only the likes of these individuals who can prevent the West from having a fate identical to the present state of Egypt and Persia, which were once advanced civilizations that are now chained by the shackles of fascistic Islamic doctrines.

Reject the Cyborg Theocracy!

To understand the techno-present we must first acknowledge it. The Media Committee invited transhumanist scholar Joe Allen, author of *Dark Aeon*, and Pastor David Engelhardt, author of *Good Kills*, to lead a conversation on the place of Christian spirituality and our emerging technocivilization.

Cyborg Theocracy—let’s define that. A cyborg is a cybernetic organism that is the direct or indirect fusion of a biological organism and a machine. The world is full of them. In fact, our entire society has become a cyborg civilization. The most common and universal example is your smartphone. While it may not be surgically implanted into your body (yet), it still serves as an indispensable tool to navigate the modern world. You are essentially a cyborg already. Your personality, movements, and other personal data exists on the network. It is still you, just your digital side. And what about the theocracy?

Imagine being hungry. After a moment of thought, a meal is ordered and a token exchanged. A sustenance drone is swiftly dispatched. Or, so busy you can’t find time for the gym? One sec—done. Scheduled with just a thought. Direct to your artificial intelligence (AI) assistant—who is also a teacher, companion, and pastor. More than just material needs, you turn to AI for guidance on theological questions. What is an appropriate prayer for this or that? What does God say about

XYZ? You may even be living on Mars, but you are not just a cyborg citizen, you are a cyborg being with a spirit.

These are the dreams—half realized—of some of the wealthiest men, the most powerful governments, and the largest corporations on the planet. Now the question: what is the boundary between the sacred and the profane? How might Christian theology exist in a cyborg civilization? Or will another theology take its place? This is the theocracy part.

A theocracy is a society ruled by gods. But that’s never how it works out. It is the interlocutors between the gods and the people—the priests—who really rule, “and to the extent that the machine is running the society, the priest is ruling by way of digital gods,” says Joe Allen. Those priests are the technocrats and the computer engineers. The ones who design, interpret, and manipulate the data and algorithms of our societally integrated technology. Their spirituality will be aggregated through the eerie soulless output of the machine.

David Engelhardt emphasizes that “there is always a theocratic battle happening...” spiritual understanding is not stagnant, good Christian principles are steadily challenged by opposing faiths and worldviews. “So we do what we want generally and then we build moral systems based upon doing what we want.” He references Romans 1:22-23, where “claiming to be wise, they became fools, and exchanged the glory of the immortal God for images resembling mortal man and birds and animals and creeping things.” In other words, Engelhardt predicts that the future of technospirituality will devolve away from the boundaries of Christian theology into a system that justifies any want of man, such as realizing the promise of everlasting life through artificial means. However, he cautions that such a system would eventually crash under its own weight, and holds steadfast that God’s law is the only eternal system. But that is not where the world is heading right now.

“I don’t think that the near future belongs to traditional Western Christendom,” says Joe Allen, “I think the near future belongs to those who worship the machines.” Those who reject cybernetics will get left behind. Will they become an untouchable class? Or can Christian theology coexist and check AI technology, upholding a just and compassionate future? How can The concept of Imago Dei, the belief that humans are created in the image of God, be applied to the enhancement

of human faculties through technology? Is not human creativity and innovation a reflection of divine attributes after all? The Club finds these questions profound and necessary as we accelerate into a singularity.
