We deployed a delegation of over 40 members to represent our Club and spent a very busy several days in lovely Budapest meeting with dozens of political parties, think tanks, NGOs (the good ones), and other organizations dedicated to aggressively defending and expanding the Western way of life.

Following the official conference, Fidesz's Foundation for a Civic Hungary outdid itself yet again introducing us to its local power players and Hungarian history by taking a smaller delegation deep into the Tokaj wine region. We

are now busy with a full year's worth of events and follow-ups until CPAC Hungary 2026, which we plan to attend with even greater numbers.

Hungary was not our only stop. Our tireless International Committee and its affiliates also attended the Forum for Democracy Youth Organisation's (JFVD) opulent summer gala in Amsterdam and engaged in their soccer tournament the day before, in Utrecht, playing as well with our friends from Schild & Vrienden of Belgium. We would like to thank again Thierry Baudet and his team for the engaging hospitality—these are truly patriots with the “right stuff.”

After the Netherlands and before Hungary, the Committee flew to “Slavic Switzerland”, better known as Slovenia, and spent two days exploring the capital and countryside with members of the Slovenian Democratic Party (SDS) and its youth wing (SDM). Productive meetings were held with parliament members Suzana Šimenko and Andrej Poglajen, an old and dear friend of the Club. We also thank the head of SDM Luka Simončič and wish their party leader Janez Janša all the best in his election next year.

For those interested in seeing and hearing what these delegations undertook last month, we encourage you to follow our Club on Instagram, where newsreels for each leg of this trip have been posted. We preceded last year's CPAC Hungary with a delegation to Alternative für Deutschland (AfD) and the Bundestag in Germany, forming lasting friendships that are still quite fruitful today.

The New York Young Republican Club will continue to doggedly attack the International Left in whatever ghastly form they may appear and is proud of the international collaborators in its fight for God, homeland, the family, and tradition. 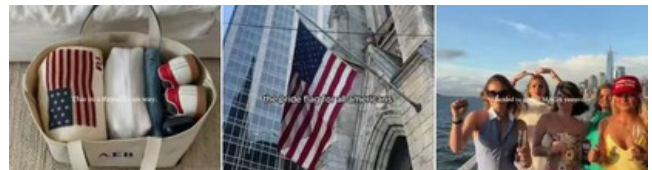

When The Dust Settles, Zohran's Primary Win Will Be Another Pyrrhic Victory for the Left

Many are shocked that a communist-socialist-Islamist trifecta in Zohran Mamdani has won the Democratic Primary for New York City Mayor. Quite frankly, I saw it coming. While there is currently much discussion about the expeditious and correct path to take, I'd like to focus entirely here on the big picture.

The nomination of Zohran Mamdani will prove to be yet another pyrrhic victory for the Democrats and the Left. A pyrrhic victory is a victory that comes at great cost, perhaps making the ordeal to win not worth it. Lately, the Democrats and the Left especially have been excelling at pyrrhic victories. Whether Zohran becomes the next Mayor of this City or not, this will be no different. Democrat moderates and traditional liberals have lost control of their party. Zohran's primary coalition was largely made up of the traditional identity politics that comes out of immigrant politics in New York City. This has been with us for as long as the city has been voting for Mayor. But the other part of Zohran's coalition is a different sort of "identity politics", the "identity politics of the white progressive."

The white progressive leftist in New York is one of three types of people, and all three voted heavily for Zohran.

Man-buns and trust funds, transplants, and the precariat.

A significant statistical number of Zohran's voters won't even be in New York in three years, in five years, and in 10 years. They are the rootless, cosmopolitan, transient class that has always been a major part of New York City's culture and politics, but never so to this extent. A fair number of them chose to be cosmopolitan rather than being born into it. I count myself among the dissenters of this type of voter. This type of small town, out-of-state voter grew up in a greatly egalitarian situation, and has never quite adjusted to the reality before them in the city. New York City can be a place of deep contrast and contradiction. On one corner, a billionaire tower. Around the next corner, a homeless person with a needle in their arm. This smaller town trying to "make it here" person is an empath. They grew up in a culture that still has social trust and a real social fabric. Yet everywhere they look they see a post-social trust, and post-social fabric society.

The irony is that nearly everything they want out of this city they were much more likely to grow up with, and they are much more likely to find it if they simply go home. Whether it's a better housing situation, cleaner streets, less economic inequality. Sure. They'll have to drive a car again. They might have to live next to red Americans. But these places have no shortage of hick-libs either or more likely in their case, hick-socialists. It is my view that the vast majority of these voters, the economically stagnant, aspiring professional class, not the proletariat of the communism of old, but the precariat of the 21st century – will eventually move home. This man-bun having white progressive transplant can never bring themselves to vote for the Republican Party, but they will one day bring themselves out of this city.

Meanwhile, rather than listen to Jack Posebiec's "get out of cities" we should double down on saving and renewing this city because saving our cities is part of saving our country.

So, I'll end with my famous white-pill optimism. If Zohran loses in the fall, we will save and renew this city together. If Zohran wins in the fall, we will save and renew this city together. And we will do it because New York City is already so severely out of step with the political direction of the nation. Like other times in history, when a civic order turns from one vision and consensus to another, NYC and the northeast establishment beltway will get pushed into a rearguard action and will realign more and more to adjust itself. It's already happening. Just a year ago, Republicans were outnumbered 7 to 1 in NYC voter registration. Today, it is down to 5.9 to 1. And back in 1993, Rudy Giuliani was able to become Mayor with that ratio at around 4 to 1.

Nationally, Republicans have won two of the last three presidential elections, and we will win five of the next six. The arrogance of the New Yorker be damned, the United States of America, with

Republican presidents and usually Republican Congresses to go with it, is going to drag this city around all century no matter who is Mayor, so the city might as well get with the program or risk becoming irrelevant.

Look to the leadership of the Manhattan Young Democrats, ossified and pointless like every other Democrat establishment institution, and to the leadership of the DSA—the real army and face of Zohran's victory. How many of them are parents? How many of them are veterans? How many of them have a business and have created jobs for other people? And how many of them will even stay in this city once the reality of "more of more of the same" proves unworkable?

The future is now the New York Young Republican Club vs. the DSA. And this 312-predictor forecasts a victory for us whether it takes one year, five years, 10 years, we will win the future because we will have the biggest stake in it.

Plan Trusters Puff Cigars, Panicans Grovel

“Obviously the war in Iraq was a big fat mistake.” This candid statement blew the blanket off the old fat pale rump of the Neocon establishment. Jeb!™ and his jewels jiggled in utter dismay. As the crowd of megadonors sneer-

-ed, Americans at home cheered and guffawed, and the political mass of star Donald J. Trump visibly swelled another order of magnitude. By the CBS News Republican Primary Debate of 2016, 15 years of misadventures in the Middle East had jaundiced Americans' regard for their Commanders and Chiefs.

“No new wars,” is a core promise of Donald J. Trump's Make America Great Again platform. His predecessors had left a mess for him to clean up, and he did so with vigor. In particular, the menacing Islamic State, the “JV team” of Al-Qaeda according to President Barry Soetoro, cast a wide swath of destruction and tyranny from Syria to Iraq. The coddled Beltway generals said their defeat would take three to four years. Trump swept them aside and gave the task to General Dan “Razin” Caine. The good General was freed from the shackles of NGOs, State Department lawyers, and nebulous Pentagon position papers, and was given a clear mission: destroy the enemy.

The result? Total defeat of the Islamic State within a couple of months and the decapitation of

their loathsome chieftain Abu Bakr al-Baghdadi, who “died like a dog.”

Fast forward past the ignominious Biden Administration to the present victory over the peculiar Islamic Republic of Iran. Leading into the Twelve Day War there was a break in trust among some in the MAGA coalition. Trump had indeed made the promise of “no new wars,” but he had also made something else very clear: “Iran cannot have a nuclear weapon.” Well, the regime has clearly been trying to make one for decades.

The festering wart bulged and risked severe necrotrophic infection. As Trump geared up to pop it, a fault quaked in the MAGA coalition. Traumatic memories of the Middle Eastern misadventures flooded to the fore in the American public mind. Was Trump about to get us involved in another forever war with a power substantially stronger and more virile than Iraq and Afghanistan? Was he compromised by the domineering state of Israel? Panicans shouted, “this is Israel's war! America First is not Israel first! What is the goal here?” A fair concern. Plan-trusters sat back confidently.

We elected President Trump to wield the awesome power of the presidency and to weigh tough decisions. Two things compelled action. First and foremost, nuclear non-proliferation is a core tenet of any common sense foreign policy. A nuclear Iran would necessitate a wider nuclear breakout in the region. American hard-won hegemony should not be surrendered due to inaction on this point. Secondly, the rambunct-

-ious American protectorate of Israel bit off more than they could chew in their surprise decapitation attack, forcing our hand—a reckless act we should not soon forget. Without swift American intervention, their air defense batteries would have been overwhelmed and Tel Aviv would have been flattened.

President Trump's coordinated strike was unprecedented in recent American history. Unlike the ill-defined regime change and nation building schemes that appear to be the only aphrodisiac available to geriatric neo-cons, this mission could

not have been more clear. Neutralize the Iranian nuclear development sites with advance notice to avoid human casualties, and allow for a symbolic retaliation on a largely vacant American base. As of this writing, the peace still holds, no American lives were lost, and Iran knows that Trump's interest stops at non-proliferation. For now, plan-trusters can tease their panican friends for their not unwarranted-freakout. Let's light a cigar and get back to the domestic agenda.

Why Global War on Terror Veterans Lean Panican and Why Grace Should Be Extended

The Twelve Day War with Iran, and America's decisive role in decimating the Iranian nuclear program through bunker buster bombs in precision strikes on Fordow, Natanz, and Esfahan brought yet an-

-other round of MAGA coalitional in-fighting to a close. On each occasion, the in-fighting has been more nuanced than most think. The America First populist coalition has always been propelled by three core issues: immigration, trade, and avoidance of forever wars. A profound failure and crack-up on any of these three issues would be devastating for the movement's long-term prospects. While many on the left and professional liberal class like to think that they'll move back to "forever rule" once President Donald J. Trump disappears, and neo-cons on the right used to think the same, I've always taken a different posture. President Trump is a consequence and champion of this movement, just as much as he has been leading it. He has earned our trust with his track record most certainly. However, one thing that distinguishes us from the automatons on the left is we have coalitional conversations and genuine viewpoint diversity. With that diversity should come a bit of grace.

On the MAGA coalitional spectrum between "plan-truster" (in Trump we trust), "monitoring the situation" (the world is a complex place), and "panican," I was a full on plan-truster with the Trump tariff strategy. That trust has been fully vindicated with the American economy improving, on its way back toward the first-term heights after four years of the Biden Democrat disaster. Nearly every country in the world, including all of Europe, is coming to the table to cut deals. The US and China have announced a trade agreement as well. As of June, the Trump tariff revenue has increased 78%, as well, to a total of 68.9 billion. Despite concerns of increased inflation over tariffs, the opposite has occurred. Just like during his first term, President Trump is proving to be an economic marvel. His amazing streak on foreign affairs, war, and peace, had also been proven in his first term. Yet, for the first time in a long time I, like many post-9/11 veterans, was somewhere between "monitoring the situation" and "panican" about our involvement in the Iran-Israel War.

Those who were full blown partisans for "plan trusting," skewed Gen Z and younger millennials and tended

to not be parents. Against this reality, everyone takes on this line up and grace should be extended toward all. Those who were not around in 2002 through 2008 need to recall just how hated the discredited neoconservatives are, how distrusted they are by not just the Global War on Terror veteran community but populists in general, and the view of the Trump coalition is very much driven by the mistakes of what came before by presidents in both parties, first George W. Bush, and then later Barack Obama. No amount of reassurance that there would not be boots on the ground was going to make GWOT veterans feel better about the situation until it was resolved or reached a point of greater clarity that, thankfully, we have now reached.

At the time just prior to an incredibly successful military operation that speaks to the incredible competence, courage, and character of our warriors who represent what is best about America, I wrote out on X my best attempt to synthesize the suspicion coming from the GWOT community:

I also think the average GWOT veteran has become so paranoid and fearful of war because we know it won't go well, we know the politicians will be chicken hawks, the left will be disgusting and call us mercenaries, and yes, "losers" and "suckers" (how we knew that story was planted and written by a leftist), and we know the media will be into the shiny objects up front and then double down on the chaos story at home after.

The rules of engagement will be stifling and get more of our battle buddies killed unnecessarily, and the neoliberal and neoconservative globalist minority will have once again ruined the United States of America at the moment a coalition majority says we're moving in the right direction.

For the third time in our lives, we will have seen defeat grabbed from the jaws of victory.

And America will lose more of its best.

And there will never be accountability.

This is not the X rant of a true partisan panican. But rather a requiem for those lost in a 20-year war that was bipartisan. That began when the Twin Towers was knocked down by Islamic terrorists who found a base in a lawless and nonexistent country called Afghanistan, and ended 20 years later with the same government who allowed that safe haven back in charge, and people falling off of the plane leaving the airport, in a scene eerily similar to "The Falling Man."

The arc of the post-9/11 veteran is that we signed up and saw the beginning of the story as another Pearl Harbor, and indeed it was far worse than that. We signed up with the purest of motives and intentions and with a deep love of country. And that story ended with a scene worse than the Fall of Saigon.

And that's why we'll keep on aggressively monitoring the situation and praying for the best. One thing's for sure though. President Donald J. Trump is cut from a different cloth. He will resist all of the forces that put America's best in that situation for two decades. His political rise and triumph is intricately linked to it. And so I believe everything will be okay. For today, and God-willing, well into tomorrow, and the future.

The Brooklyn GOP Establishment is Dead; Long Live the NYYRC!

June 25, 2025

The New York Young Republican Club celebrates the resounding victories of our endorsed candidates in tonight's primary elections. As the results come in and the dust settles, the truth is now obvious: MAGA is ascendant in New York City and the RINO Brooklyn GOP establishment is, thankfully, dead. All four of the candidates that our Club endorsed in tonight's elections won their primaries. Inna Vernikov trounced her ex-Democrat opponent; it took the Associated Press barely forty minutes to issue a call. Frank Morano's race was over before it started. In Smithtown, incumbent Supervisor Ed Wehrheim was handily reelected. And most dramatically of all, George Sarantopoulos defeated the Republican County Chair in his home district.

As the star of the New York Young Republican Club rises, it is clear that the establishment party apparatus in Brooklyn is dead. The failed insurgency by a well-connected cabal of ex-Democrats collapsed; the People of Brooklyn made their voices clear: Inna Vernikov is the new powerbroker in Kings County. For supporting a renegade grifter against the shining star of the Republican Party, the cabal of ex-Democrats who tried to steer this campaign for her opponent revealed their true selves: shameless hacks who are, ultimately, the authors of their own destruction.

What is next for the Brooklyn GOP establishment, after such a shameful defeat? While they may possess the fancy titles, it is clear from tonight's results that the decision-makers in the Brooklyn GOP do not represent the will of their constituents. Instead of throwing his weight behind the obvious candidate for the 47th District, the Republican County Chair actually decided to run against Sarantopoulos himself. The selfishness of Richie Barsamian is a stain on the

Republican Party; it has no place in the GOP and neither does Richie Barsamian.

As George Sarantopoulos's margin of victory over Barsamian is under the required margin, the election will proceed to a recount. But since Barsamian is also the County Chairman, he will appoint the people who actually conduct the recount – a conflict of interest if a politician ever had one. The New York Young Republican Club calls on Barsamian to recuse himself from the recount process if he desires to retain any credibility with the public. In truth, however, justice demands more than this. The proper role of the Republican County Chairman is to recruit candidates to run for public office. Barsamian's choice to run for Council himself is a violation of his office; his failure to break even half of the vote should be taken as a sign of no-confidence in his leadership. The New York Young Republican Club calls on him to do the right thing and resign, tonight.

The devastation of Ari Kagan, as well, illustrates deep-seated problems within the Republican establishment in Brooklyn. A dedicated grifter known for unfailingly losing elections, Kagan was a propagandist for the Soviet Army before settling into a more comfortable role as a local Democrat. On the City Council between 2021 and 2023, Kagan voted to the left of even his party comrades. In early 2022, he voted down \$325 million to the NYPD – which passed regardless, with Democrat support. Intent on making New York unlivable, he voted to close Rikers Island and create open-needle heroin injection sites for addicts.

When he noticed the area shift to the right, Kagan grifted to the Republican Party later that year. Did his views change with his party allegiance? Far from it. Even after "joining the GOP," Kagan

voted to give trauma care to illegal immigrants, create a commission to study “lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, intersex, [and] asexual” orientations, and, last but certainly not least, create a Homeless Bill of Rights that guarantees the God-given, inalienable right to sleep on the street. Sensing his grift, voters roundly rejected him for reelection at the ballot box later that year.

Kagan tried to rebound by stabbing the Republican Party in the back two years later. Recognizing that his hometown would never elect him again, Kagan ran in the neighboring district, challenging the successful incumbent Inna Vernikov. In healthy organizations, such self-aggrandizement and double-crossing would promptly earn Kagan a pink slip. With the Brooklyn GOP, it landed him endorsements. State representatives Michael Novakhov and Alec Brook-Krasny, themselves ex-Democrats who we exposed in a previous statement, rushed to Kagan’s defense, endorsing him over the popular incumbent. Ignoring the endorsement of Donald Trump Jr. for Councilwoman Vernikov entirely, the so-called “Donald J. Trump Kings County Republican Club” threw their weight behind Ari Kagan.

With tonight’s final results, the grift of the ex-Democrat Brooklyn cabal is exposed at last. The voters saw through their transparent hoax and

resoundingly rejected their candidates. Ari Kagan, perennial grifter, is gone at last. Richie Barsamian will resign tonight if he cares for his political future. Frank Morano’s opponents are not worth mentioning. Alec Brook-Krasny and Michael Novakhov, at the core of the ex-Democrat cabal, are now irrelevant, politically. The ex-Democrat grifter cabal is no more; real MAGA Republicans are firmly in control of our Party.

When it comes to Republican politics in New York City, the New York Young Republican Club is now the only game in town. Repeat After Us: Remigration!

A statement from the New York Young Republican Club International Committee

The following statement was published to honor the first Remigration Summit, held in Milan in May, 2025. The statement was read aloud at the summit:

A historic conference in Milan has rendered the deep state occupational governments of Europe frenetic: the Remigration Summit 2025. This international gathering, the first of its kind in well over half a century, was organized by various political and activist groups from across Europe united in support of remigration, a policy advocating the return of immigrants and their inassimilable descendants to their countries of origin.

As this conference faces intensive backlash, protests, bomb threats, and all the other resistance expected from gangster EU oligarchs and their antifa auxiliaries (human detritus),

attention must turn to the German patriots, including two young women, arrested at the airport en route to the Summit and banned from exiting Germany until after the Summit’s conclusion. After hours of interrogation, German authorities explained that these young citizens could pose a “significant risk of damage to the reputation of the Federal Republic of Germany” if permitted to attend the summit. As stalwart

Austrian patriot and lead organizer of the Summit Martin Sellner noted, “the democracy simulation has been turned off,” and the true deep state of Germany has revealed its will and earned the reputation it deserves. Other attendees were similarly blocked, including Rasmus Paludan of Denmark. Our comrade Dries Van Langenhove may only be able to attend because of a last-minute delay to his spurious criminal trial in Belgium.

Considering the above actions and many past offenses, we assert that the current German government is tyrannical and possibly illegitimate, functioning much like that of the occupational German Democratic Republic, whose byzantine rules and draconian surveillance state severely crushed ethnic Germans’ rights and wantonly degraded their standard of living. The phenomenal Alternative für Deutschland (AfD), now the most popular party in Germany despite repeated attempts by the questionable Berlin regime under Friedrich Merz to ban it, has established many strongholds in the former East Germany, where people remember communist oppression and yearn for freedom and self-determination. This most recent action, even given the terrible German Basic Law, is likely legally dubious and vulnerable to litigation. As freedom- and identity-loving Americans, we know what must be done: down with the Verfassungsschutz (Federal Office for the Protection of the Constitution), the Bundesnetzagentur (Federal Network Agency), government-controlled media authorities, and all other heads of the hydra stemming from the German Basic Law’s limits on freedom of speech and association. **Germany needs a revolution!**

We Americans understand the stakes. Each day, we watch America-hating courts stymie President Donald J. Trump’s mandate to undertake the largest deportation of illegals in world history. Mass deportation is not only justified but necessary after decades of poor border security and reckless immigration policy, which catalyzed tens of millions of illegal entries and a shocking demographic shift. While Europe’s invasion is more recent and not yet as severe, it is no less dire. We implore all Europeans to defend their ancestral homelands and not let them balkanize into multiethnic bazaars stripped of European identity, legacy, and history.

Please pray for the American nation as we undertake this essential effort. As of mid-May 2025, Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) has deported over 65,000 individuals since President Trump’s return to office. This figure includes both formal deportations and voluntary departures facilitated by the Administration’s incentive programs. Illegal border crossings have reached historically low levels under President Trump’s leadership. In April 2025, Border Patrol apprehended approximately 10,000 migrants, a dramatic decrease from over 128,000 in April 2024. This represents a 92% drop year-over-year. In March 2025, the number of illegal border crossings was even lower, with just 7,181 encounters. This marks a 95% decrease from March 2024, when there were 137,473 apprehensions. These are promising figures for the first few months, but much remains to be done! Ultimately, tens of millions—every illegal bar none—must leave.

Remigration is a necessary policy and a compelling ideal. Teach its meaning to a new person every day. Mamdani for Mayor: An Ode to Remigration

In the June 24 primary elections, the Democratic Party will field a range of radical left-wing candidates. Andrew Cuomo, the fairy godmother of bail reform, faces off against Zohran Mamdani, a socialist so radical that even Alexandria Ocasio Cortez (NY-14) refuses to endorse him. Eric Adams, who narrowly escaped criminal charges for fraud and corruption, will watch on from the third-party sidelines. Zohran Mamdani is so radical, however, that it is not enough for New Yorkers to reject him at the ballot box; he must be outright encouraged to remigrate from the United States.

Indeed, Mamdani faithfully represents the 9/11 Caucus of the Democratic Party. Like Rep.
